• CPAS - On 23rd May there was online training to ensure that every child has a chance to explore Jesus led by CPAS staff, please pray that this training was well received and will be put into practice through out the church.

- Tearfund Limited access to schooling in Niger. Security concerns continue to limit access to schooling for children in some regions of Niger. This situation particularly affects those who live in remote areas. Many young people are exposed to protection risks, such as child labour, forced marriage and recruitment into armed groups. Pray for God's protection over children in Niger and pray that they have access to the education opportunities they need to thrive.
