**5** Now when Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, <sup>2</sup> and he began to teach them.

- He said:
- <sup>3</sup> 'Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- <sup>4</sup>Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- <sup>5</sup>Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.
- Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- <sup>7</sup>Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
- <sup>8</sup>Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.
- <sup>9</sup>Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.
- <sup>10</sup> Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness,
  - for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

"'Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. "Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

#### 2 Corinthians 12:1-10

12 I must go on boasting. Although there is nothing to be gained, I will go on to visions and revelations from the Lord. <sup>2</sup>I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know - God knows. <sup>3</sup> And I know that this man - whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, but God knows - <sup>4</sup> was caught up to paradise and heard inexpressible things, things that no one is permitted to tell. <sup>5</sup>I will boast

about a man like that, but I will not boast about myself, except about my weaknesses. <sup>6</sup>Even if I should choose to boast, I would not be a fool, because I would be speaking the truth. But I refrain, so no one will think more of me than is warranted by what I do or say, <sup>7</sup> or because of these surpassingly great revelations. Therefore, in order to keep me from becoming conceited, I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. <sup>8</sup> Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. <sup>9</sup> But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. <sup>10</sup> That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
